Since its inception in 2023, Hunar Healthcare has redefined what vocational training can mean in the healthcare sector — bridging the gap between skill and service, between learning and healing. What began as a modest initiative grounded in empathy has grown into a movement of purpose-driven education. In classrooms once marked by silence, there is now the steady rhythm of ambition — of students mastering clinical skills, engaging in real-world training, and preparing not just for jobs, but for lives of impact. Healthcare Workforce Development Expands to Lahore!

In March 2024, a transformative grant from The Abdullah Foundation enabled the launch of the Hunar Healthcare Farouq Ahmed & Aftab Shamsi Technical Institute (FAASTI) initiative — an ambitious effort to deliver specialized, high-impact healthcare training in Lahore. With a focus on practical, market-relevant skills, the initiative introduced the Healthcare Assistant program on August 1, 2024, and has since gained strong momentum.



Strategic partnerships with leading hospitals have secured 100% on-the-job training opportunities, resulting in a 74% job placement rate across the first two cohorts. A total of 200 students enrolled — 65 in the first batch and 135 in the second — demonstrating growing community trust and demand. These milestones underscore Hunar Healthcare's commitment to equipping Pakistan's youth with the competencies needed for a growing healthcare sector and a more inclusive, resilient workforce.

From its very first day, FFHTI has bridged ambition with achievement by offering specialized healthcare courses—including Healthcare Assistant, Nursing Assistant, Critical Medical Technician, Physiotherapy Technician, and Community Midwifery — designed to produce a workforce ready for both local and global demand. Complementing this, FFHTI nurtures communication and global mobility through language programs in Japanese, Chinese, Arabic, English, and German, opening doors for

overseas employment and cultural integration. Beyond traditional training, FFHTI is pushing the boundaries of innovation with AI-powered cancer detection tools, 3D-printed surgical guides and prosthetics, and the development of a state-of-the-art physiotherapy clinic — advances that promise affordable, life-changing healthcare solutions. With cutting-edge labs, hands-on learning, and strong industry linkages, FFHTI is preparing its students not just for jobs, but for leadership in healthcare and technical fields. This launch marks a bold step towards creating a skilled, compassionate, and globally competitive workforce, uplifting families, empowering communities, and paving the way for a healthier, stronger Pakistan.

Recognizing the importance of early exposure, Hunar Healthcare introduced first aid and emergency response training at Happy Home School System – planting the seeds of healthcare awareness among young students. These interactive sessions taught practical life-saving skills while sparking interest in healthcare as a viable and meaningful career path. Beyond the classroom, the initiative served as a powerful outreach tool, connecting skills to tangible outcomes.
